5 Levitical Offerings & Sacrifices

- Burnt Offering
- Meal Offering
- Peace Offering
- Sin Offering
- Trespass/Guilt Offering

Not all Offerings were for Forgiveness of Sin

3 voluntary expressions of worship

Burnt or whole offering

Grain offering- no blood

Peace or Fellowship Offering


2 mandatory expressions of remorse for sin

The Burnt offering: Leviticus Ch.1

- This is for the Atonement
- Male without blemish of the herd or the flock
- All burnt on alter
- Nobody can eat from it
- Can also be birds but has to be Turtle doves or young pigeons



The Grain offering: Ch.2

- Fine flour or oil
- Frankincense
- Season with salt
- No Leaven or Honey
- The priest shall burn a handful as a memorial on the altar
- The rest of the grain shall be Aaron and his sons



The peace offering: Ch.3

- Male or female of herd (cows, sheep, goats)
- Without blemish
- The fat, kidneys, and the lobe attached to liver are all for God
- Aaron's sons shall burn it
- The one who offers it can also eat from it (Leviticus 7;20)



The sin offering Ch.4

- To forgive unintentional sins
- Blood and fat on the altar and the priest who makes atonement with it shall have it
- If the anointed priest sins, he sacrifices for his sin a young bull
- If the whole congregation of Israel sins unintentionally, they also sacrifice a young bull
- If a ruler sins, he shall sacrifice a male goat (without blemish)
- If anyone of the common people sin, female goat (without blemish)
- Bullock burnt on the altar without camp



Trespass Offering: Ch.5

- To forgive trespasses, you sacrifice female from the flock (lamb or goat)
- Could also be two turtle doves or young pigeon, one as a sin offering and one as burnt offering.
- Can also offer 1/10 of an ephah of fine flour
- Fat, fat tail, two kidneys, and the fatty lobe attached to the liver are for God
- Priests can eat it in a holy place



“The remainder of the flesh of the sacrifice on third day must be burned with fire.” (Leviticus 7:17)




